History

'**Montrose**' was the name first given to the building constructed in the years 1867-1869. Neighbouring properties included The Glebe Hotel, now Badde Manors, built in 1864, and the house next door, 22 Glebe Point Rd, built in the 1860s. A large frangipani tree in our courtyard is thought to have been planted in the late 19th century when Montrose was first established.

Since 1899 Montrose has almost continuously been used as a surgery and doctor's residence. Drs Arthur and William West were followed by the Potts family, a father-and-son duo who practised here for almost seventy years. From 1920 till the 1940s, Dr Potts visited his patients in a horse-drawn buggy, which was kept in a stable at the back of the building.

In 2008, restoration of the heritage building was commenced. After twenty months of heritage analysis and conservation work, the elegance of Montrose once again makes a handsome contribution to the streetscape of Glebe Point Road. A heritage award confirms the success of the restoration.

In 2014 extensions were undertaken, with the distinctive architecture combining modern and classic elements. The new space provides extra rooms for GP consultations and the Montrose Allied Health Clinic found on the first floor.

Appointments

Appointments can be booked online or by calling us on 02 9660 6788. **A brief appointment with a GP is 15 minutes.** If you require a longer appointment please let us know when booking on the phone. Longer GP appointments may include Mental Health Care Plans, Procedures or Vaccinations. Emergencies will always be given priority, which may mean that your appointment may be delayed. Reception staff will inform you if this is the case.

Cancelling an Appointment

Please call to advise the reception team or reply to your reminder SMS to cancel/change an appointment. Cancellation of GP appointments within 3 hours of the appointment time will be subject to a late cancellation fee. Cancellations of allied health appointments differ. You may find more details on our website.

Fees

Montrose is a private billing practice. Discounted rate will apply to all children under the age of 16, full time students, pension card and concession card holders on weekdays. Full fees apply to all appointments on the weekends. Allied health service fees differ based on practitioners. Payment is required at the time of consultation.

Test Results

All results are strictly confidential and will not be given to patients over the phone through reception staff. The doctor will advise you as to when you may expect your results. All urgent results will be followed up with the patient directly.

Recall system

We use SMS, phone or email to issue medical reminders for the best preventive healthcare. If you do not wish to be a part of this system, please speak to your doctor.

Scripts and Referrals Request

Repeat prescriptions and/or referral renewals can be made via our online booking system. Please allow at least 48 hours for processing. A \$25 fee is required to be paid prior. If you have not seen your GP in the last 3 months, an appointment will be required to renew your script/referral.

Phone Access to your Doctor

A short non-urgent message relating to your previous/following consultation can be taken down at reception and conveyed to the GP.

Email Correspondence

We do not take clinical requests and bookings via email. Please book in a consultation with your GP to discuss your healthcare. We only contact patients via email with your consent.
